- Mentions local RTA's name and contact information; mentions affiliation with the Indiana Retired Teachers Association
- Includes a photo



Guidelines for Websites:

- Links to www.retiredteachers.org
- Is website; is not a blog
- Is not all on one page; contains active links
- Includes contact information through website
- Has calendar of events
- Includes up-to-date news
- Shows date of last revision
- Includes community service/personal achievement stories
- Includes legislative updates
- Has good overall appearance
